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# **COMMON DEDUCTIONS**

Do you qualify for any of these deductions? Here's what you'll need if you do.

0	Homeowner Expenses  Mortgage interest statements (Form 1098), property tax payment receipts, energy efficient upgrade receipts (Form 5695) and qualified moving expense receipts for work-related moves more than 50 miles.
$\bigcirc$	<b>Education Expenses</b> Tuition statements, itemized receipts of qualified educational expenses (Form 1098-T) and student loan interest state- ments (Form 1098-E).
$\bigcirc$	Charitable Contributions  Detailed list of donations, receipts for contributions over \$250 and Form 1023 for vehicle donations.
$\bigcirc$	<b>Self-Employment Expenses</b> Records of business/home-office expenses, assets, pension plan contributions, health insurance payments and estimated tax payment receipts (state and federal).
$\bigcirc$	Child and Dependent Care Expenses  Name, address and tax ID or Social Security number of the provider.
$\bigcirc$	Health Care Expenses Records of medical and dental costs.
$\bigcirc$	Alimony Expenses  Your ex spouse's full name and Social Security number.
$\bigcirc$	Job Hunting and Job-Related Educational Expenses Records of expenses
$\bigcirc$	IRA Contributions Form 5498
$\bigcirc$	Health Savings Account Contributions Form 5498-SA
$\bigcirc$	<b>Tax Payments</b> Receipts for all state and federal taxes, property taxes, vehicle license fees and sales tax.
$\bigcirc$	Tax Preparation Expenses  Receipt for having last year's taxes professionally prepared.
